El Puente Research Fellowship under El Centro de la Raza supports and promotes undergraduate research in multiple academic areas. It offers undergraduates the opportunity to prepare for graduate level education over the course of two semesters. El Puente Fellows work closely with graduate




mentors and faculty as they increase their understanding and experience of academic research. This fellowship takes the educational experience to the next level and better prepares students for future opportunities in the academic and professional world.

Fellows engage in a research project of their interest with the guidance of our Instructional Team during the fall and spring semesters. During the program, El Puente Fellows participate in mandatory seminars which provide them the knowledge and tools necessary to begin the research process, develop a research proposal, and prepare for graduate school.

El Puente Fellows also have the opportunity to grow as a community of scholars with the other fellows. As research projects develop, fellows have a space to rely on their peers and mentors for input, guidance and critiques. Most importantly, all the fellows are on similar journeys toward professional development and/or a graduate degree. It is important to note that prior research experience is not required as this program meets the students at their level.

Requirements:

With guidance and support, fellows are expected to complete the following capstone projects during the 2021-2022 fellowship:

- Create an original Research Question
- Complete a Literature Review
- Develop a Research Proposal
- Present Research Proposal
- Develop a Letter of Intent for graduate/professional school
- Attend two-hour bi-weekly seminars (every other Friday, 2-4pm)
- Meet with assigned research group for 1 hour a week

Eligibility

You must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible for acceptance into the fellowship:

- □ Enrolled at UNM for Fall 2021 & Spring 2022 and able to commit for full academic year
- □ GPA of 3.0 or above preferred
- □ Undergraduate student with a minimum of 30 credit hours (completed or in progress at time of application/Rising Sophomore)
- □ Must meet 1 of 3 of the following criteria:
 - o Member of an underrepresented ethnic group in higher education
 - o First generation college student
 - o Qualify as low-income
- □ Please note that this program is open to any student regardless of immigration status
